**JOINT REQUEST FOR FILING CERTAIN DOCUMENTS UNDER SEAL**

In accordance with the Stipulation and Protective Order approved by this Court on January 16, 2018, MoneyGram Payment Systems, Inc. designated certain documents and deposition transcripts as “Confidential” during the discovery phase of this case.
