PIERRE N. LEVAL, Special Master:

Delaware, with the consent of the Defendant States, requested by email that all pending deadlines be extended until Friday, August 4, 2023 to facilitate ongoing discussions regarding the potential resolution of this matter. Delaware's request is hereby granted.

Briefs in opposition to Pennsylvania's motion for an order directing withdrawal of deposited funds should now be filed by August 4, 2023. Pennsylvania may file a reply brief 7 days thereafter.

The case schedule is further modified as follows:

- **1. Initial written discovery to be served:** August 4, 2023.
- 2. Parties to submit a joint status report with respect to the funds in escrow: August 4, 2023.
- 3. Fact discovery, including document discovery, depositions, and any third party practice, to be completed: 180 days from the initial service of written discovery.
- **4. Initial reports from retained experts due:** 90 days from the completion of fact discovery.
- **5. Rebuttal reports from retained experts due:** 60 days from the filing of initial expert reports.
- **6.** Expert depositions to be completed: 45 days from the filing of rebuttal expert reports.
- 7. **Dispositive motions due:** 45 days from the close of expert depositions.
- 8. Tentative trial date: Q4 2024.
