Dear Mr. Harris:

On December 6, 2016, the Court invited the parties to file a joint stipulation of facts within sixty days. The Court further provided that, if such a stipulation was not filed, then a "Special Master will be appointed to conduct any necessary discovery and to make proposed findings of fact."

In response to the Court's order, the parties conferred and attempted to prepare a joint stipulation of facts. The parties, however, are unable to agree on a joint stipulation of facts at this time.
