Cory J. Feinberg, being first duly sworn, hereby deposes and says.

1. I am the Associate General Counsel for MoneyGram International, Inc. (“MGI”). I make this affidavit from my own personal knowledge and from my review of documents and records maintained by MoneyGram.

2. MoneyGram Payment Systems, Inc (“MPSI”) is a direct wholly-owned subsidiary of MoneyGram Payment Systems Worldwide, Inc. MoneyGram Payment Systems Worldwide, Inc., in turn, is a direct wholly-owned subsidiary of MGI.

3. MPSI is incorporated in the State of Delaware and has its principal place of business in the State of Minnesota. MPSI was incorporated on or about January 4, 1996, and has remained a Delaware corporation at all relevant times.

4. MGI is incorporated in the State of Delaware and has its principal place of business in the State of Texas.

5. Prior to 2005, Travelers Express Company, Inc. (“TECI”) was incorporated in the State of Minnesota and had its principal place of business in the State of Minnesota. Prior to 2005, the Official Check business at issue in this case was conducted by TECI.

6. On June 30, 2005, TECI was merged into Travelers Acquisition, Inc., a Delaware corporation. In connection with that transaction, Travelers Acquisition assumed the TECI name. Thereafter, TECI was converted into a Delaware limited liability company and merged into MPSI on December 31, 2005.

7. From December 31, 2005 to the present, the Official Check business has been operated by MPSI.
