## ORDER

PIERRE N. LEVAL, *Special Master:*

Upon reading the submissions of the parties in response to the October 26, 2022 conference, I have studied the question whether I should adhere to, or change, the recommendation I made to the Supreme Court in my First Interim Report. My draft of my new submission to the Court will be completed in a few days. The Guide for Special Masters requires that a Special Master's reports be printed. In the customary practice of the Supreme Court, up to three printed copies of such reports are distributed to each party at the Court's expense. When the First Interim Report was submitted, the majority of Defendant States were satisfied to receive only an electronic copy.

Delaware, Arkansas, and Pennsylvania are requested to advise me by email whether they require printed copies of the Report and, if so, how many. Arkansas is additionally requested to canvas the other Defendant States and to inform me which Defendant States, if any, require printed copies and how many.

The parties are requested to advise of their responses by Thursday, December 1st.
