PIERRE N. LEVAL, *Special Master:*

By Order dated June 29, 2023, the Special Master directed the close of fact discovery to occur on January 31, 2024, 180 days after initial service of written discovery. On September 12, 2023, the parties submitted a joint request that the Special Master extend the close of fact discovery by 30 days, from January 31, 2024 to March 1, 2024. The parties' request is hereby granted.

The case schedule is modified as follows:

1. **Fact discovery, including document discovery, depositions, and any third party practice, to be completed:** 210 days from the initial service of written discovery.
2. **Initial reports from retained experts due:** 90 days from the completion of fact discovery.
3. **Rebuttal reports from retained experts due:** 60 days from the filing of initial expert reports.
4. **Expert depositions to be completed:** 45 days from the filing of rebuttal expert reports.
5. **Dispositive motions due:** 45 days from the close of expert depositions.
6. **Tentative trial date:** Q4 2024.
